

Youth Advisor

Congregation Shaarie Torah (CST), a Conservative congregation in Portland Oregon, seeks a part-time youth advisor. This includes creating a social community for youth grades 3-12th. Integrating youth activities to be a part of United Synagogue Youth (USY) and synagogue programming to create a vibrant kehillah is critical to the position.

Specific responsibilities include: creating, recruiting and promoting participation at age appropriate social events, assisting in recruitment to regional and national events and conventions; developing and executing programs for Clubs (grades 3-5), Kadima (6-8) and USY (9-12); building teen leadership within our synagogue providing leadership and supervision as necessary; coordinating with regional and national USY leadership; and supporting and maintaining religious standards. Applicants should be prepared to work with youth and families in the context of the larger synagogue community.

Candidate works closely with the education director on informal educational programs, participates as a team member of the CST, represents CST at all times in a manner reflective of an atmosphere of warmth, caring and Jewish spirit.

20 Hours per month. Youth advisor must be prepared to work Sundays and some evenings.
