Youth

Initiating and executing bi-monthly programs geared specifically to our Kadima and USY'ers. (grades 6th through 12th grade)

The Youth Director will be responsible for all aspects of the Youth Department, including communications, recruitment, ordering & shopping for supplies, calendaring, registration, budgeting, and collections.
